<input type="checkbox"/>	Letter of Recommendation	Submit three (3) letters of recommendation; one from your Sunday School/ Bible Study instructor, or ministry chair; a second letter from a school counselor or teacher, a third letter from a community/ civic leader, or employer
<input type="checkbox"/>	Transcript	Include an official sealed transcript from your high school counselor AND an official college/university transcript from the 1st semester showing a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher .

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ESSAY TOPICS

1. For even as the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many. Write a personal statement describing your interest and involvement in community service. The statement should address why community service is important to our society and how you intend to continue serving your community in the future.
2. What are some of the factors that prompted you to choose the career that you are interested in? Present an important fact about the history of your chosen career. Cite the contributions to that career by either a person in history or a contemporary figure who impresses you.
3. In the book of Genesis, God asks Cain about the whereabouts of his brother. Cain replied with "Am I my brother's keeper?" What does being "my brother's keeper" look like today in our 21st century society? From your perspective, explain how this view might guide you to impact your community.

Awards are competitive, and range between \$500 and \$2000. They will be awarded during the second semester of your freshman year.
